Active Membership Requirements*:

Our Jr. Development team has grown and grown and each year we have been turning away families every year due to time and resource limitations.

Our Jr. Development team is run 100% on a volunteer basis and all workers, drivers, riders, organizers are not compensated in any way to run and support Jr. practices.

Each year the entire team has grown and the cost to maintain this growth has been challenging. The regular members have been generating over 90% of all revenue for the team and there has been an ongoing effort to increase the contributes provided by our younger members and families to support and sustain the growth of our Jr. program.

To retain an active membership for all Ski Otters, we are requiring all members to participate in at least two fundraisers during the year (helping coordinate, work, organize, promote the event – or simply attending and/or getting auction items for the silent auction) – current fundraisers include: wine tasting events, annual Jr. Team Gold Plate Dinner.

In addition, for all Ski Otters we are offering a reduced membership (Active) if you sign up for any one of the following options as part of your membership commitment.

- 1. I will bring in \$300 in advertising or sponsorship revenue (program ads, trailer ads, jump ads, etc)**
- 2. I will be a driver at each Jr. Team practice or find a replacement on days I cannot attend (must be certified driver and approved by show directors).**
- 3. I will be a rider (requires showing up to regular team practices and safety certification) at all Jr. Team practices or find a replacement on days that I cannot attend.**
- 4. I will ensure that the equipment trailers are there for each practice and show or will find a replacement on days that I cannot.**
- 5. I will help coordinate/organize/work the concessions that are sold during each show and special event.**
- 6. I will work at the Ski Otter stand during all Thursday Market Fest events (or find a replacement on days that I cannot attend).**
- 7. I will help coordinate and organize prizes for the silent auction at the Gold Plate dinner.**
- 8. I will help maintain the site each week (lawn care, weed clean-up, beach raking, etc)**
- 9. I will help pass out and collect costumes each show (or find a replacement on days that I cannot attend)**
- 10. I will help maintain, wash, and repair costumes each week**
- 11. I will find a sponsor for a major prize (over \$1000) for year end raffle**
- 12. I will make props or costumes for the team**
- 13. I will set-up and take down sound system each week and find a replacement for days I can not attend**
- 14. I will commit to skiing at regular practices and ski shows**
- 15. I have another idea I'd like to bring up for consideration on a way to contribute to the team**

In addition to the above, it will also be a requirement that each member help maintain our gas sponsorship and fill up at a Freedom gas station. All team participants are expected to turn in at least 20 Freedom gas receipts by end of summer.
